Public Comments        None.

Minutes        Bill made a motion to approve the July 2009 meeting minutes as presented. Jim seconded and Ted voted yes.

Road Report     Bill reported the following July activities: The following roads are completed: Camp, Lyon, State Line, Upper Rhiney, Cross, Howard Hill, Cabin Hill West (topped Lyon Hill and Yoehans Hill), Cabin Hill East, Mucky Run, Buck, and English Flats. Sluices were put in on English Flats, Buck Road, Stone Crop, Lyon, State Line, Barbour, Cabin Hill, Mill Road, and Tripp. Shadow Brook and Barbour roads are also complete.

Treasurer's Report     The supervisors discussed Cintas recent service: one week no service at all and 3 and 4 pairs of pants back on two different occasions. The supervisors decided to deduct one week payment for the unacceptable service.
