

The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on April 1, 2010 at 7:01 p.m. Present were Bill Goodrich, Ted Plevinsky, Jim Lindsey, Lori Raub, Don Rifenbury, Clifford Reed, Lennie Kalechitz, and Linda Rockwell.

Public Comments Lenny Kalechitz reported that the FEMA flood maps are now posted on the township web site.

Minutes Bill made a motion to approve the March 2010 meeting minutes as presented. Jim seconded and Ted voted yes.

Road Report Bill reported the following March activities: service was done on the roller and grader, repairs on the Ford tractor, cleaned sluice heads, graded some bad areas, and pulled plows and spreaders off of the trucks.

Treasurer's Report Linda noted that the \$50 donation for the Snake Creek Volunteer Fire Co. annual Easter egg hunt will be written tomorrow.

Ted made a motion to reimburse Betty Phillips \$843.91 for laptop computer, printer, and ink. Bill seconded and Jim voted yes. Ted explained the grant for the tax collector computer and printer to the citizens present.

Bill made a motion to accept the March 2010 Treasurer's Report as presented, pay Bill List 04-10, pay any bills which are normally paid at the monthly meeting, and pay the payroll for April. Jim seconded and Ted voted yes.

Scheduled Public Input Don Rifenbury asked if Scott Neir is selling stone for \$8.75/ton. Ted checked our sheets and 2-B is \$11.10/ton delivered to the township building. Discussion centered on still needing the state approval certificate.

Don asked if COG is back on a regular schedule. Ted said, "No." He encouraged Don to call and set up an appointment.

New Business Bill reported that Bob Chiarilla from the Snake Creek Volunteer Fire Co. wants to have a community bonfire at Liberty Park for Liberty and Franklin Township residents. He further noted that a burn ban is going into effect.

A question was raised on the Route 29 repair at Brookdale. PennDot is going to begin the repair the first part of June when school is closed and it will continue for four months. Bill went on to explain the detours.
