

The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on September 1, 2011 at 7:01 p.m. Present were Bill Goodrich, Jim Lindsey, Ted Plevinsky, Clifford Reed, G.T. Southworth, Violet Henry, Lennie Kalechitz, Len Kalechitz, and Linda Rockwell. Nancy and Randy Payne entered the meeting at approximately 7:30 p.m.

Public Comments None.

Minutes Bill made a motion to accept the August 2011 Meeting Minutes as presented. Jim seconded and Ted voted yes.

Road Report Bill reported the following August activities: Grading was done on various roads. Hunsinger had a washout, Mt. Valley had ditch work completed, Valley View needed repairs, mowing and trimming was completed, storm damage was completed on various roads. In addition, G's Excavating was hired to clean out the Bailey Road Bridge. A bulldozer was rented from Down to Earth Equipment Rentals #2 to do repair work on Bailey Road. Discussion ensued on the bridges holding up during the storm. An e-mail from PSATS: FEMA does not include Susquehanna County for storm damage. Bill also noted that Damascus is raising prices 25 cents/ton effective on 9/1/11.
