

The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on September 7, 2017 at 7 p.m. Present were Bill Goodrich, Dave Bailey, Erika Johnson, Wayne Doc Luce, Alton Wilber, Jim Lindsey, Mary Jane Bolles, Clifford Reed, Lori Raub, and Linda Rockwell.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Public Comments A discussion ensued on Liberty Park noting that they have about \$400 and still need help. Both the Park Association and the township are covering the buildings with the Park Association to assume liability costs. When they receive their insurance bill, Doc will call Jim Davis, the township's insurance agent, and set up a meeting with the Park Association and the township to discuss the insurance.

Minutes Linda noted that Bill had pointed out on the last line under new business should read "loader", not "grader" as printed. Bill made a motion to accept the August Meeting Minutes with the noted correction. Dave seconded and Alton voted yes.
