

The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on August 6, 2020 at 7 p.m. Supervisors present: Doug Sivers, Dave Bailey, and Alton Wilber. Secretary/Treasurer and Alternate Secretary/Treasurer present: Linda Rockwell and Janette Tiffany. Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Public Comments Retired Snake Creek Volunteer Fire Chief Mike Adams expressed major concerns regarding the fire company. The request was made for the supervisors to look into the matter. Doug stated the obligations of the township were to pay the workers' compensations, and forward the fire tax. The fire department is a separate entity from the township. The supervisors will schedule a meeting and report back at the next meeting.

Minutes Dave made a motion to approve the July 2020 Meeting Minutes as presented. Doug seconded and Alton voted yes.

Road Report Dave reported the following July 2020 activities: grade, rake and roll; finished Lyons, Lower Rhiney Creek, Mill, Trip, Camp, Jones, Shanty, and Valley View.

Treasurer's Report Linda noted the following: all quarterly reports had been filed, an audit of the Workers' Compensation required \$350 additional, Franklin Township has been billed for their portion of the Workers' Compensation as provided by DGK Insurance, and a request has been made from Cintas to enroll in on-line billing. Doug suggested that Cintas be asked to provide their statement by e-mail. Dave made a motion to accept the July 2020 Treasurer's Report, pay Bill List 08-2020, pay any bills which are normally paid during the month and pay the payroll for August. Doug seconded and Alton voted yes.

Old Business Dave reported that the tire/metal cleanup day was a success with more tires than last year, and the metal bin is reasonably full.

Alton reported that Vince Heron had left an estimate on work to be done on the Grange Hall but did not have it with him.
