

MODEL ORDINANCE FOR CREATING A  
TOWNSHIP, BOROUGH OR CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

An Ordinance No. 2

An ordinance signifying the intention and desire of the

Board of Supervisors of the  
Board of Supervisors/Board of Commissioners/Council

Township of Susquehanna, County,

Pennsylvania, to create and establish a Township  
Planning Commission

Planning Commission under the provisions of the Pennsylvania

purpose of preparing and adopting a plan of development for the

Township of Liberty based on  
Township/Borough/City  
the physical, social, economic and governmental conditions and

trends, and to encourage the coordinated development of the  
Township of Liberty and the general  
Township/Borough/City  
welfare and prosperity of its residents.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the  
Governing Body

Township of Liberty  
Township/Borough/City

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors  
Board of Supervisors/Board of Commis-  
sioners/Council  
of Liberty Township hereby

signifies its intention and desire to organize a Township  
Township/Borough/

City  
Planning Commission under the provisions of the Pennsylvania  
Municipalities Planning Code, Act 247 of July 31, 1968, as amended  
and supplemented.

Section 2. The Planning Commission shall consist of

5  
3 to 9 members, all of whom shall be citizens of the Township  
Borough/City of Liberty. The term of office of the  
members shall be four (4) years or until a successor is appointed,  
except that the terms of the members first appointed shall be  
so fixed that on a commission of eight (8) members or less, no  
more than two (2) shall be reappointed during any future calendar  
year, and on commissions of nine (9) members, no more than three  
(3) shall be so reappointed or replaced. In the event of vacancies  
the governing body shall appoint a member to fill the unexpired  
term. Members whose terms have expired shall hold office until  
their successors have been appointed.

Section 3. The names, addresses and terms of office of  
the members of the Planning Commission are as follows:

Section 4. That the Planning Commission shall prepare and adopt a plan for the development of the Township of Liberty, and which plan of development shall be based on studies of the physical, social, economical and governmental conditions and trends and shall be designed to promote with the greatest efficiency and economy the coordinated development of the Township of Liberty and general welfare and prosperity of its residents.

Section 5. All other resolutions and ordinances or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
