

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD NO. 743 FROM A POINT TWELVE HUNDRED (1200) FEET WEST OF THE GREAT BEND-LIBERTY TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE OUTLET OF MUD POND, NOW MINGO LAKE.

The Township of Liberty hereby ordains as follows:

All that portion of Township Road #743, the approximate centerline of which is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Liberty Township Road #743, 1200 feet West of the Township line, the same point being near the intersection of a private road leading to the Shields property; thence continuing on T-743 in a Southwesterly direction, the following distances: 4+00 feet - point in Township road near private road of Shields property along South side owned by Keystone Water Co. and North side of Shields; 7+45 feet - point in road and center of old stone culvert under road adjacent to the ones commonly named Barry property; 10+65 feet - point in road centerline opposite a five foot diameter tree near existing foundations visible from road; 41+55 feet - approximately center of intersection of T-743 and abandoned road that at some time in the past connected to T-804 in Mountain Valley; 46+25 feet - approximate point in center of road in front of remnants of old carriage shed at Lake Farm; 48+00 feet - approximate location of sharp curve in road as it passes through lawn and proceeds West-ly along North side of lake; 57 75 feet - center of outlet of lake as it passes through stone culvert under T-743.

That the said road shall become a private road of the width of twenty five (25) feet for the use and benefit of the owners of lands through or along which it passes, to be maintained and used as private roads are now maintained and used under existing laws.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect May 1, 1980.
