

Establishing an Agricultural Area in Liberty Township.

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Area Security Act (Act 43 of 1981) provides a strategy to strengthen agriculture in Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, Several owners of agricultural land in Liberty Township have petitioned the governing body to establish an agricultural area in said Township;

WHEREAS, It is understood and intended owners of agricultural lands within an established agricultural area are entitled to special considerations from local and state government, as more fully described in Act 43 of 1981, as amended;

WHEREAS, It is desirable for Liberty Township to form an agricultural area to conserve and improve agricultural land in said Township;

WHEREAS, Liberty Township has complied with Act 43 requirements for public participation for a proposed agricultural area within said Township;

WHEREAS, the Township Planning Commission and Agricultural Area Advisory Committee have reviewed this proposal and endorsed same;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Liberty Township Board of Supervisors, in consideration and full understanding of the aforesaid facts, does hereby adopt the "Liberty Township Agricultural Area No. 1 of 1986." The duly executed forms (Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture - AAO-95 February 1982) and property maps relative to this Agricultural Area are hereby incorporated and made part hereof.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, The Board of Supervisors of and for the Township of Liberty, Susquehanna County, have caused this resolution to be adopted and enacted this 6TH day of MAY 1986, at a regularly scheduled meeting of said Board of Supervisors.
