Steve Roe made the motion to sign the BOR letters to change insurance agents to Kilmer Insurance, Lori Raub seconded. Darin DeRose said yes. Motion carried.

An update on the Grange Hall was given. Lori said the stained glass windows are being worked on and that she expects to see the painters soon! Residents made suggestions for signs and generators.

Darin DeRose gave the road report. Lots of roads are in progress, in mid-April they will start hauling material to the roads.
